Personal data processing and protection

In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27. April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Regulation), Masaryk University informs data subjects about the circumstances under which their personal data are processed during the implementation of the lifelong learning programme Scriptorium Brunense Summer School of Auxiliary Historical Sciences (hereinafter referred to as Scriptorium Brunense), which will be held from 27 June to 1 July 2022 at the Faculty of Arts of Masaryk University.

Personal data controller

Masaryk University (hereinafter referred to as MU, the controller) is a public university of the university type according to the Higher Education Act. Within the framework of its main mission, it freely and independently carries out educational and related scientific and research, development and innovation, artistic or other creative activities and related activities.

Data subjects, i.e. participants of the Scriptorium Brunense, may contact the Data Protection Officer in case of any questions or requests regarding the processing and protection of personal data or to exercise their rights.

Processing of personal data

MU processes the personal data of participants in Scriptorium Brunense Lifelong learning (hereinafter referred to as LLL) only to the extent necessary to register the participant and ensure the organisation and teaching of the Scriptorium Brunense programme. Personal data is stored on MU storage facilities with monitored access, protected by a system of access rights and secured to the maximum extent possible according to the standards of the controller and in accordance with applicable law.

In processing, the controller complies with all the principles for the processing of personal data under the General Regulation. The principles and rules for processing personal data at MU are regulated by MU Directive No. 1/2018 "Protection and Processing of Personal Data".

Purpose of processing personal data

The purpose of the processing of personal data of the participants of the Lifelong learning is the organizational provision and implementation of teaching in the lifelong learning program Summer School of Auxiliary Historical Sciences Scriptorium Brunense.

Categories of processed personal data

Masaryk University processes the following categories of personal data of participants in the electronic application for participation in Lifelong learning:

- 1. Identification data
- 2. Contact details
- 3. Details of previous education.

Legal grounds for processing personal data

The personal data of the participants in the Lifelong learning programme are processed pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the General Regulation, i.e. the processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party.

Transmission of personal data

The Data Controller does not transfer the personal data of Lifelong learning programme participants to third parties, abroad or to international organisations.

Period of storage of personal data

The controller will process the personal data of the Lifelong learning programme participants according to the file mark 4.3.1 of Annex 1 of the MU Directive 2/2016 Rules of Procedure - the participant's file will be stored in the MU Faculty of Arts file room for 10 years and then transferred to the MU Archives as archival material.

Rights of the data subject

The data subject has the following rights under the General Data Protection Regulation

- withdraw consent to the processing of personal data,
- request access to personal data,

- · request correction or deletion of personal data,
- · require restrictions on processing, and
- object to the processing of personal data concerning him or her.

Exercise of data subject rights

The data subject is entitled to exercise his or her rights under the General Data Protection Regulation against the controller, either

Taking photographs and videos

The data subject acknowledges that during the lifelong learning programme Scriptorium Brunense, photo documentation and video recordings of a reportage nature will be made and and as such they will be published on the Masaryk University institutional website and on social networks managed by the Department of Auxiliary Historical Sciences and Archive Studies, Faculty of Arts, Masaryk University (facebook, youtube, etc.), for a period of two years from the beginning of the summer school, i.e. from 27.6.2022 to 27.6.2024. Due to the overall nature of the photographs and video recordings thus obtained, in which the participants of the lifelong learning programme Scriptorium Brunense will not be displayed in the form of a portrait and the published documentation will not be provided with data that would lead to their unambiguous identification (name, surname, university number, etc.). in the sense of § 84 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code, the taking and subsequent processing of this documentation is not conditioned by the consent of the data subject.
